


Asset-Backed Securities




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Asset-Backed Securities (ABS) are securitized instruments that offer exposure to the loans market through a wide range of risk profiles. The underlying loans can be :

- Small Medium Enterprise (SME) Leases/Loans

Advantages

Exposures to diversified granular assets (systemic risks)

Mainly floating rates payment

Transparency of underlying assets

Alignment of interest between originators and investors with retention rules



Disadvantages

Complex regulatory framework

Extensive credit analysis (cash flows, documentation review, credit risk analysis)

Relatively lower liquidity compared to mainstream fixed income products

Maturity extension risks
